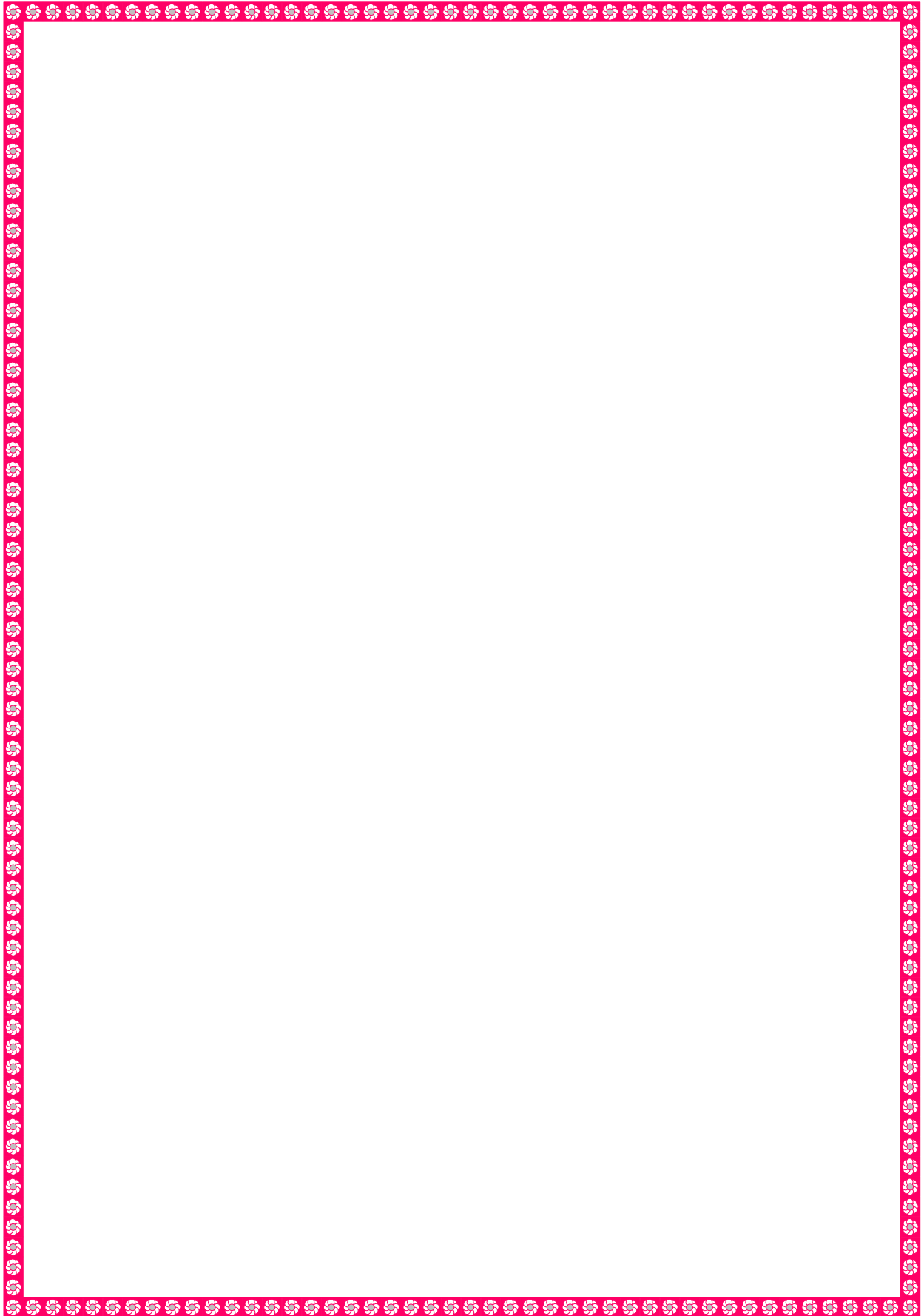

INTRODUCTION

KAIROS, the socio-economic and pastoral development organization of the Diocese of Kannur has applied for assistance for furnishing the newly constructed training centre from where trainings and educational classes on social and ecclesiastical topics are being conducted for the clergy and the laity in the Diocese of Kannur and the neighbouring Dioceses. The issue proposed to be addressed is the inadequacy of furniture and training facilities in the newly constructed training centre to conduct a more elaborated and days' long trainings and classes for the trainees.

The newly constructed training centre can accommodate 70 participants at a time. But there aren't sufficient furniture like coats, desks and tables, chairs, writing boards as well as the modern electronic equipments like LCD projector and screen and Televisions, etc. If the centre is equipped with adequate furniture we could conduct residential trainings. At times, residential trainings are required as the participants and the resource teams come from faraway places from different Dioceses. When the trainings are on social issues, our participants are usually from faraway places of the two districts which are markedly distant from each other.

Under this circumstance, a well furnished and well equipped training centre was a must and our appeal for financial support was approved by you for which we are very much thankful to ***Missionary Sisters of St. Peter Claver, Rome.***

ACHIEVEMENTS

We have achieved the target proposed in our project application. The following materials and furniture items are purchased and placed in the training centre.

- a. Metal Coats – 9
- b. Mattresses of fibre form – 9
- c. Steel Cupboards – 8 (One each for individual room)
- d. Tables – 5 (One each for individual room)
- e. Office Chairs – 5
- f. LCD Projector with accessories - 1

These furniture and equipments are arranged properly to make the training centre and the residential arrangements look more professional. Now any team can come and conduct residential and non-residential training programmes in the training centre. There is another special matter to be mentioned that the training centre has turned to be a source of income for KAIROS as the centre is being used by other agencies for rent.



The output of the project is:

an adequately furnished and equipped professional training centre with facilities for residential training programmes



established and provided for the use of the trainers and training institutions including Government and NGOs.

The Results are:

- A well furnished training centre for the use of Social and Ecclesiastical training programmes established
- Comfortable stay and training hall arrangements available for residential training programmes
- Training facilities at affordable charges for outside agencies

The outcomes are:

- Trainees feel a homely atmosphere during the training programmes
- A source of income for the Diocesan Social Development Agency (KAIROS)
- Facilities to organize own training programmes for the groups and staff of KAIROS without any difficulties and apprehensions.
