Introduction

Save A Family Plan (SAFP) is a non- governmental and voluntary development organization with a vision of 'Partnering with the poor for a just a world'. The inspiration and charism of SAFP's founder, Msgr. Augustine Kandathil, has become the corner stone of SAFP through which thousands of families are being assisted to come out of poverty. SAFP has maintained strong donor base supporters, a consistent network of thousands of volunteers, development organizations, developmental & technical professionals and thousands of grassroots level people's organizations actively involved in the development process.

Mission: partnering with the poor for a just world.

Activities: Save a Family Plan through Family Development Programme provides financial aid to selected families which numbers up to 225 families who need a helping hand and KAIROS plays a very important part in reaching out to the neediest families of the region and coordinates timely support for them through the Project of Save a Family Plan for a time period of 6 years. Every financial year an amount of Rs 30 lakhs (30,00,000/-) is been transferred to them. Through this support families are able to cater to their requirements and have a stable income source by doing small business initiatives and live stock farming.

We at KAIROS, extend our service to Save a Family Plan Project by conducting seminars, trainings, skilled workshops, and helping them to start small business initiatives.



Community Development Project under Save a Family Plan

1. Covid Rehabilitation Project

The partner families of Save A Family Plan has been affected by the pandemic and the impact of the Covid in the community resulted social and economic difficulties especially losing jobs and reduction in sales & profitability from small business Initiatives. Through the Covid rehabilitation program Save A Family Plan envisages to build back better the life of the partner families who have been affected by the impact of Covid especially in social and economic realms.



2. Golden Jubilee Housing Program

Golden Jubilee Housing Program is the continuation of the Housing Project launched as part of Golden Jubilee Celebrations of Save A Family Plan India (SAFPI). This project aims to build safe and secure houses for the impoverished families who deprived of decent living shelters. On the occasion of the Housing program the fund was contributed by SAFPI for the house construction, an amount of Rs 2,00,000/- was directly disbursed to the BENEFICIARY's bank account.
